## Introduction

The Royal Government of Cambodia's powers and functions database contains powers and functions extracted from laws, sub-decrees, prakas and other legal instruments that pertain to the work of Cambodian government agencies in the delivery of services to the public and the necessary support for this delivery. The database is supported by the Administration Reform and Decentralization Program and the EU Programme for Strengthening Performance, Accountability and Civic Engagement (EU-SPACE).

The database is classified into sectors and sub-sectors. These sectors and sub-sectors are based on the nature of activities performed by government without necessarily corresponding precisely to line ministry mandates, and therefore represent a practical, not legal interpretation. A sector in this database, therefore, may encompass tasks and responsibilities performed by a number of line ministries, although usually one ministry is the lead agency. Conversely, a single line ministry may have involvement in multiple sectors.

The database is then classified into functions and sub-functions. A sub-function is a task or responsibility set out in a legal instrument that is reproduced in the database nearly word-for-word. For exact wording of sub-functions, however, reference should be made to the applicable legal document. A function is an aggregated description of a set of related sub-functions. Each function reflects, as closely as possible, an output or service. The sub-functions associated with a function in the database, however, may not capture all sub-functions that are required in order to fully deliver that output or service. A function may include sub-functions extracted from more than one legal instrument and may include sub-functions that are undertaken by different agencies. Please note that while sub-functions are drawn directly from legal instruments, the functions are not and should, therefore, not be construed as a legal interpretation. The functions have been created by technical advisors for the purpose of readability and to facilitate discussion.

All information in the database is linked to a reference legal document and the concerned institution or agency. In some cases, the legal documents associate a line ministry with a sub-function although that sub-function, in reality, may have been delegated by the ministry to a line unit. In those cases, the database reflects the legal framework only. Where the legal instruments do specify the sub-functions of departments or offices, this is specified in the database.

The database also captures available information on powers and functions decentralised (devolved) and delegated to commune and sangkat councils following adoption of the Law on the Administration and Management of Communes and Sangkats in 2001.

The Royal Government's powers and functions database has been used to produce the following list of functions for the health sector and the Ministry of Health.
