



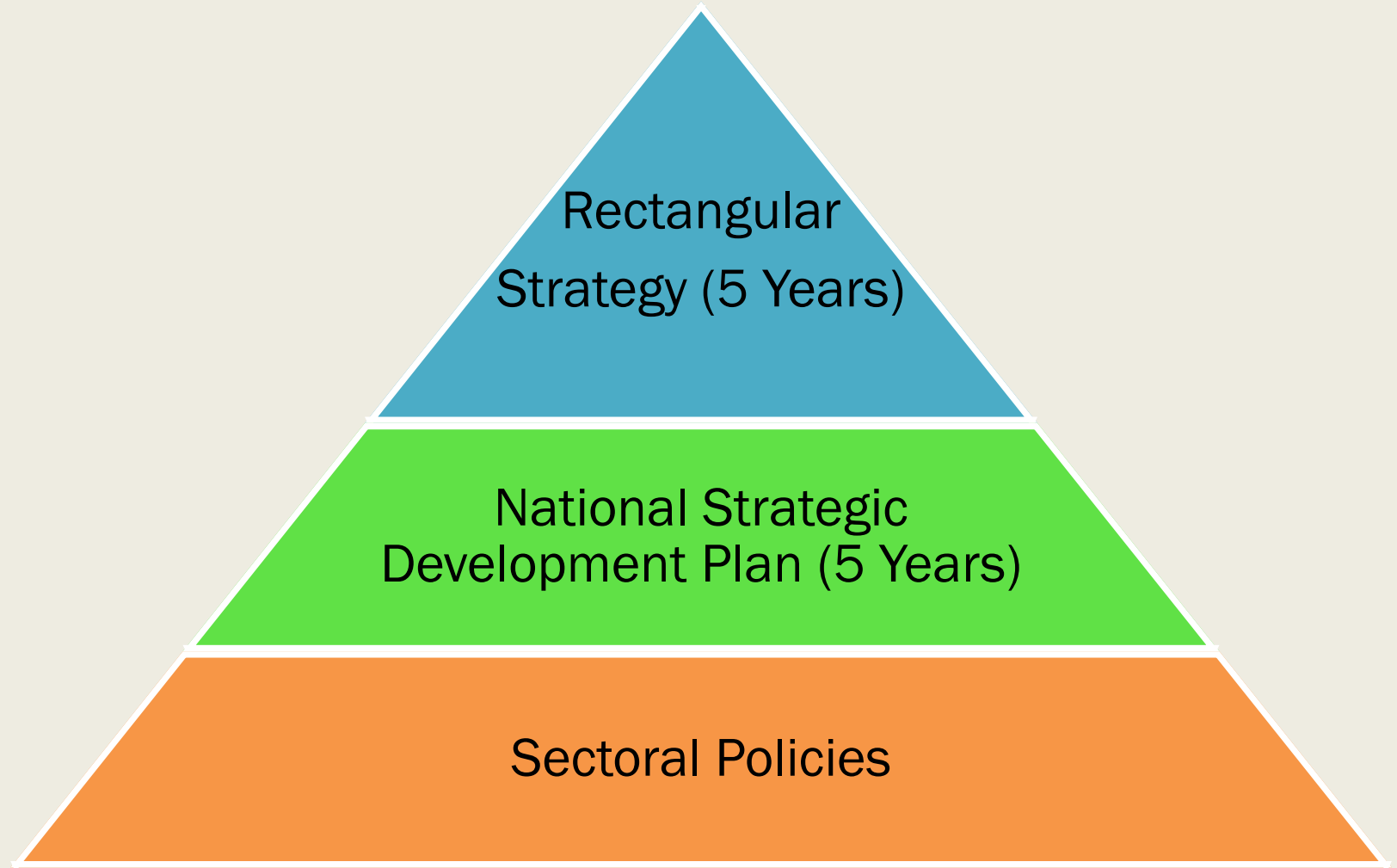

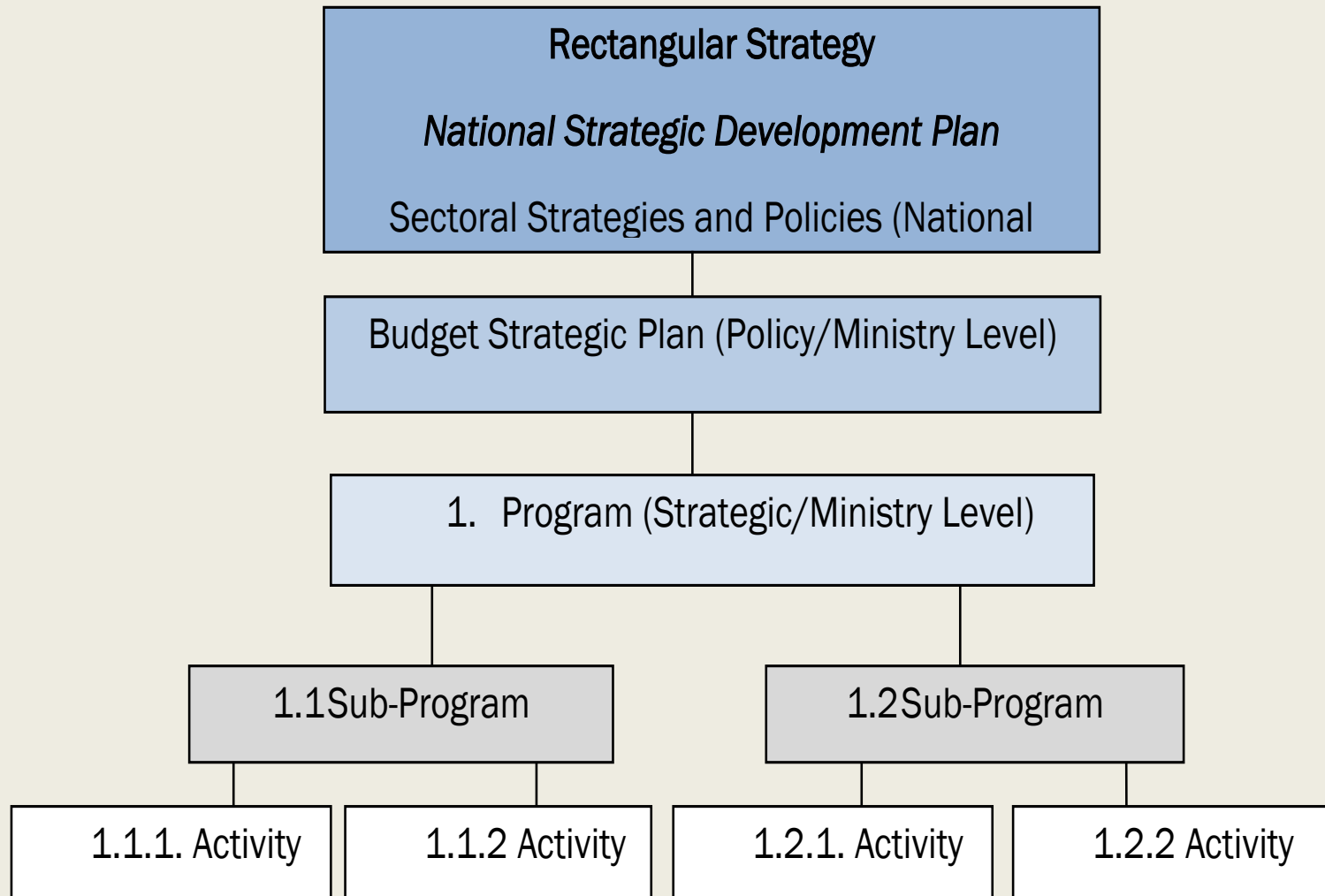
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National Policies

National Policy and Budget Linkage: MOEYS (2/3)

Examples of Budget Allocation in 2018 to Support Education Policy 1 and 2

Policy 1: Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning for all

- Increase school operation budget to improve quality of teaching and learning at school levels: 80 billion riels
- Provide scholarship to poor students to expand access and ensure inclusive education: 45.4 billion riels
- Establish another three new generation schools to improve quality of high school education and improve school based management: 2.6 billion riels

Policy 2: Ensure effective leadership and management of education staff at all levels

- Strengthen education service provider by increasing budget to district office of education: 4.7 billion riels
