ON
THE BASE DAILY WAGE

The Senior Minister and Minister of Justice
and
The Secretary of State of Social Affairs, Labour and Veteran Affairs

- Referring to Reach Kret No. NS/RKT/1094/83 of October 24, 1994 on the Reorganization of the Composition of the Royal Government of Cambodia;
- Referring to Reach Kret No. NS/RKT/1094/90 of October 31, 1994 on the Reorganization of the Composition of the Royal Government of Cambodia;
- Referring to Reach Kram 02/NS/94 of July 20, 1994 promulgating the Law on the Organization and Functioning of the Council of Ministers;
- Referring to Reach Kram No. NS/RKM/0196/17 of January 24, 1996 promulgating the Law on the Establishment of the Ministry of Social Affairs, Labor and Veterans Affairs;
- Referring to Anukret No. 56/ANK/BK of September 23, 1997 on the Organization and Functioning of the Ministry of Social Affairs, Labor and Veterans Affairs.

IT IS HEREBY DECIDED

Article 1:

The Base Daily Wage shall be equivalent to Eight Thousands Riels (R8,000.00).

Article 2:

The Base Daily Wage prescribed in Article 1 shall be the standard level used for calculating fine as provided for in Chapter 16 of the Labour Law.

Article 3:

This Joint Prakas shall take effect as of the date of its signature.
